## 1. Purpose of the release note

As part of our commitment to continual improvement, we have implemented several enhancements to the Flood Re Portal based on user feedback and concerns. Our primary objective is to optimise the system’s performance. The key changes are as follows:

1. **Streamlined Validation Rules:** We have refined several validation rules to enhance the efficiency and effectiveness of the process.
2. **User Feedback Integration:** The changes reflect our dedication to addressing user feedback and ensuring a more user-friendly experience.
3. **System Behaviour Adjustments:** Users will observe slight modifications in system behaviour as a result of these updates.

This document provides a detailed overview of the changes and their impact on the system.

## 2. Important Changes

All users must clear their cache before they log in to the Flood Re portal, this is to ensure you are using the latest version of the platform.

The following changes to logic have been made across our underwriting and claims validations;
